ITEM 400

APPLICATION OF CHARGES

1. When special type of flat car as described in Item 510 are used or are ordered and placed but not used, the USE and DETENTION charges named in Item 500 will apply in addition to the transportation charges, demurrage charges and all other terminal or charges lawfully applicable in the United States and Canada, and are to be paid by shipper or consignee and accrue to the carrier owning or leasing the equipment.

To determine the additional use charge under Item 500, find the Rate Basis Number applicable from origin station to destination station as provided in:

Item 450, when between points in the United States, as named.

Item 460, when from or to points in Canada (See Item 215).

and apply the additional use charge named in Item 500 for that Rate Basis Number.

ITEM 450

- 1. Additional use charges named in Item 500 will apply from or to stations in the United States as set forth below (See Item 460 for application from or to stations in Canada.)
 - A. Between all stations and points taking same rates in Tariff OPSL 6000 Series, for which Rate Basis is provided in tariffs referred to in Item 275 of this tariff, apply such Rate Basis Number, disregarding letter suffix, if any.
 - B. Between stations in Column 1 of Item 300 on the one hand, and stations shown opposite thereto in Column 2 of Item 300 on the other, apply Rate Basis Number as shown in Column 3 of Item 300.
 - C. Between stations and points taking same rates in Tariff OPSL 6000 series, for which Rate Basis is provided in tariffs referred to in Item 275, on the one hand, and stations in Column 1 of Item 300, on the other. Determine Rate Basis Number to apply as follows:
 - 1. Between station in Column 1 of Item 300 and station in Column 2 of said item, find applicable Rate Basis in Column 3 thereof.
 - 2. Between said station in Column 2 of Item 300 and stations for which Rate Basis provided in tariffs referred to in Item 275, find Rate Basis provided in such tariff (disregarding letter suffix, if any).
 - 3. Add rate basis number determined under paragraph (1) to rate basis number determined under paragraph (2) the sum of the two being the Rate Basis Number applicable from origin to destination.
 - 4. When more than one station is shown in Column 2, of Item 300 opposite the station in Column 1 the Rate Basis Number to apply from origin to destination will be the lowest rate basis number arrived at by separately applying the procedure described in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) in constructing rate basis numbers over each of the stations so named in Column 2.
 - D. Between stations for which rate basis numbers are not otherwise provided in this item apply rate basis over 2000.

ITEM 460

FROM OR TO STATIONS IN CANADA

- 1. Additional use charges named in Items 500 or 643 will apply from or to stations in Canada. Rate Basis Numbers to be applied from or to points in Canada to determine the USE charge under Items 500 to 643 will be ascertained as follows:
 - A. On movements from or to stations in Canada, to or from stations and points taking same rate in Tariff OPSL 6000 series, additional charge for use of cars will be assessed on the through miles obtained by application of actual miles published by Canadian Railway, in individual lines distance tables, to or from the international boundary or station adjacent thereto, as the case may be, plus rate basis number applicable as provided in Item 450 to or from the international boundary adjacent to point at which the carrier transporting the property to or from Canada, via said point, crosses the boundary.
 - B.
