

What is Tank Car Mileage Equalization?

Tank Car Mileage Equalization (TME) is a process between carriers and private car owners supervised by the STB in accordance with tariff <u>RIC 6007</u>.

Who is responsible for reporting mileage?

Mileage is reported by railroads through the Car Hire Data Exchange Process (CHDX). Roads can adjust reported mileage via the Tank Car Mileage Equalization application. Railroads have until May 21st each year to report adjustments for the prior calendar year.

Who receives the monthly TME report for my mark?

The monthly TME reports, as well as the finalized yearly report are sent to the Tank Car Mileage Equalization contacts listed in FindUs.Rail for a mark. For instructions on how to view a contact in FindUs.Rail, see <u>FindUs.Rail | Railinc</u>.

What does the '*' indicate on my monthly TME report?

A '*' next to an item on the TME report indicates that the information is new or updated from the previous report.
